

ANY ENTRY BLANKS WITHOUT COMPLETE INFORMATION, NOT SIGNED OR NOT ACCOMPANIED BY FEES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of twenty five (25) dollars to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows.

OWNERS AND HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, and entering the same dog twice, regardless of who may make such errors or duplicate entries.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for keeping the premises clean around their crates and set-ups.

DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. Any unsupervised dogs in distress may be removed from a vehicle by whatever means necessary. By entering this show the owner, exhibitor or handler agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the German Shepherd Dog Club of East Tennessee or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OF-FICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT

Routes to the Show:

Going south on I-75:

In Knoxville, continue on I-275 South to I-40 West. Take exit #386B (Rt. 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). NOTE: the exit is less than one mile from the on ramp, so *watch closely*. Follow Rt 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past airport), and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Going west on I-40:


Take Exit #386B (exit sign reads Route 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). Follow Rt. 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Same as above directions.

Going east on I-40/North on I-75:

Take Exit #376 in Knoxville, and go towards Maryville/Alcoa on I-140. Exit I-140 at the Alcoa/Route 129 exit, and drive south on Rt 129. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past airport), and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Driving Directions from Host Hotel to Dog Show:

Head north on Hall Road, and travel approximately 1.1 miles towards the airport. Take the Hunt Road exit, and continue to the right on Hunt Road. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
