

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for keeping the premises clean around their crates and set-ups.

DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. Any unsupervised dogs in distress may be removed from a vehicle by whatever means necessary. By entering this show the owner, exhibitor or handler agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the German Shepherd Dog Club of East Tennessee or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Routes to the Show:

Going south on I-75:

In Knoxville, continue on I-275 South to I-40 West. Take exit #386B (Rt. 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). NOTE: the exit is less than one mile from the on ramp, so *watch closely*. Follow Rt 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past airport), and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Going west on I-40:


Take Exit #386B (exit sign reads Route 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). Follow Rt. 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Same as above directions.

Going east on I-40/North on I-75:

Take Exit #376 in Knoxville, and go towards Maryville/Alcoa on I-140. Exit I-140 at the Alcoa/Route 129 exit, and drive south on Rt 129. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past airport), and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Driving Directions from Host Hotel to Dog Show:

Head north on Hall Road, and travel approximately 1.1 miles towards the airport. Take the Hunt Road exit, and continue to the right on Hunt Road. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS AND PRACTICES

GENERAL PRACTICES:

Clubs, officials & participants are required to follow state, local & facility guidelines that are in place on the weekend of this event. Exhibitors need to wash hands as frequently as possible. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils - bring your own. Exhibitors must provide their own scoops for cleaning up from their dogs in public ex-pens & the entire facility. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer & personal use masks. Know the arm band numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.

RING SIDE HOLDING AREAS:

Defined holding areas will be provided outside the rings. These areas will be marked on the floor. Due to social distancing, these areas will be limited & in high demand. Unattended crates will be removed by show officials. Due to social distance requirements some exhibitors will not have ring side crating. No exceptions.

SUPERINTENDENTS, SHOW SECRETARY & CLUB TABLES

- **1**.Forms (move-up, etc.) will be handed out upon request, bring your own pens to fill out forms.
- 2 Exhibitors waiting to be helped must maintain 6 ft distance from the next person.
- 3. A "look at " catalog will not be available.
- 4. There will not be a premium list, education, and judges results table available for the exhibitors.



SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS AND PRACTICES

German Shepherd Dog Club of East Tennessee (GSDCET)

Please be informed before entering our event. The GSDCET will strive to take every measure to protect all who attend the two-day event May 1/2, 2021. Under the guidance of Blount County Health Department and the AKC best practices, we will have in place several safety protocols; signs will be posted, please follow them. We ask all who attend to adhere to all of these protocols. If you do not you will be asked to leave the grounds for the rest of the event weekend. Please practice social distancing by staying 6 feet apart at all times. Be aware of your surroundings and be courteous. Masks are required to be worn at all times on the property, including in the ring.

Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local & facility guidelines that are in place on the weekend of this event. Be advised these rules are subject to change by the day of our events based on current events and status.

- 1.Exhibitors need to wash hands as frequently as possible.
- 2. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- 3. Avoid touching dogs that are not under you care.
- 4. Avoid common use pens/pencils bring your own.
- 5.Exhibitors must provide their own scoops for cleaning up after their dogs in the entire facility.
- 6. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer and personal use masks.
- 7.Know the arm band numbers for your entries BEFORE going to the ring.
- 8.Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.
- 9. While showing your dog, you must wear a mask and maintain social distances with other exhibitors.



RING SIDE SEATING:

Due to social distancing, seating will be no closer than 6 ft. to the ring. This area will be marked with tape. You may bring your own chair to sit and watch judging. An appropriate distance will be marked where you can place your personal chair. No one other than show officials, people currently exhibiting their dogs & dog holders will be allowed near the entrance/exit to the ring.

WAIVERS AND WRISTBANDS:

ANYONE attending the GSDCET Specialties, May 1/2, 2021 must sign the enclosed waiver and turn it in the first day you arrive. The waivers will go into a file. You will then be given a waterproof wrist-band to wear for the whole weekend. If you aren't seen with one on your wrist or you have misplaced it, the file will be checked for a waiver and you will be given a new wristband if there is a wavier there. If there is no waiver in the file, then you will sign one (or another one) and you will get a new wristband.

TO OUR EXHIBITORS
