Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

Neither GSDC of East Tennessee, nor anyone connected with the presentation of this event, assumes any responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to their families or children.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

FROM THE NORTH

South on I-75 in Knoxville, continue on I-275 South to I-40 West. Take exit #386B (Rt. 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). NOTE: the exit is less than one mile from the on ramp, so *watch closely*. Follow Rt 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past

airport), and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Going west on I-40: Take Exit #386B (exit sign reads Route 129 Alcoa, Airport, Smoky Mountains). Follow Rt. 129 towards Alcoa and the airport. Same as above directions.

Going east on I-40/North on I-75: Take Exit #376 in Knoxville, and go towards Maryville/Alcoa on I-140. Exit I-140 at the Alcoa/Route 129 exit, and drive south on Rt 129. Take Hunt Road exit (~0.5 miles past airport),

and turn right, over the overpass. Drive approximately 0.4 miles to Springbrook Road, and turn right. Turn left onto Alcoa Road, and then right onto Dalton Street. Show site is on the right.

Driving Directions from Host Hotel to Dog Show:


